If you have gear, you need to cable it up, and it doesn't take long before you need a lot of cables. A good way to manage them is to use multi-channel plenum, or "snake" cable. Michael Ashton (Ashton Research) will introduce AES72, a new standard for using Ethernet cable as four-channel analog snake. We'll talk about how it works and how to apply it. We'll also explore the history of multi-channel analog audio connections.

Tomita: Synthesis Techniques

Saturday 2:00 PM


Juanito from Modular for the Masses will guide you through the process of building your choice of effect or sequencer module.
